QUEEN'S BADGE REGULATIONS

The **Queen's Badge** is the highest award that may be gained by a member of The Boys' Brigade.

The Queen's Badge will be awarded to Candidates who qualify as follows:-

1. **Hold the President's Badge.**
2. **Attend a Queen's Badge Candidates' Meeting.**
3. **Participate in Skills-based training.**
4. **Take Responsibility within the BB or Church.**
5. **Provide Service or Support to others outside the BB or Church.**
6. **Develop Interests (Skills, Physical, Expedition)**
7. **Participate in a Completion Residential.**
8. **Record Activity.**

Full details of the regulations for the Queen's Badge can be found in the Queen's Badge Record Book or on the BB Website.

The Company Captain must complete a report on the young person's work and progress throughout this period and recommend them for the Award.

Note: Those candidates that registered for the Queen's Badge before the changes to the regulations in September 2008 are permitted to complete and apply for the Queen's Badge using those regulations. From September 2008 all candidates registering for the Queen's Badge should use the new regulations as set out above.

PRESENTATION

This is the highest award that may be gained by a member of The Boys' Brigade and its presentation should be made formally at a suitable ceremony.
