Guidance notes

Expectation

The charity/cause should have significant appeal to Members and Leaders throughout The Boys' Brigade in Northern Ireland. This may mean a Northern Ireland based and registered charity.

The beneficiaries of the charity should include young people aged 4-18 who are geographically spread across Northern Ireland.

The charity should not be in conflict with the Christian ethos of The Boys' Brigade (Northern Ireland District).

Relationship

There should be mechanisms for regular feedback from the charity during the year and at least the following session.

Impact

The monies raised should have a clearly identified benefit and ideally there would be an opportunity for The Boys' Brigade (Northern Ireland District) to gain some learning (e.g. programme resources to educate Members) and appropriate publicity.

Distinctive

Where possible, nominations should be different to prior years (i.e. the past five sessions). While partnering with a charity again is possible, priority will be given to new relationships.

Governance

The charity must be registered with the appropriate Charity Commission and give a written undertaking that the monies raised will be clearly directed to the agreed beneficiaries.
